The Family Justice Center initiative has been so effective that CASA has more than doubled the number of survivors and children served through this outreach initiative – a total 1,673 survivors were served through the CASA Family Justice Center — in just one year.

Innovation: The CASA Family Justice Center has been so successful in shifting the service delivery paradigm, CASA earned national recognition as the 'Outstanding New Service Launch' in the United States by DomesticShelters.org, a prestigious organization in the domestic violence field.

Excellence: Not only has the CASA Family Justice Center received a 99.9% positive feedback rate from participants, CASA was awarded a four-star rating on Charity Navigator for the sixth year in a row – a feat only 9% of nonprofit organizations in the U.S. have achieved.


